DATA DICTIONARY Last Updated: July 2024

This table provides the monthly data on the seasonally adjusted number of families and children who are recipients of the Affordable Child Care Benefit (ACCB), beginning from September 2018.

Background: The Affordable Child Care Benefit is a monthly payment made to eligible families to help them with the cost of child care. Eligibility is determined by factors such as income, family size, and type of child care.

Seasonality refers to recurring patterns that happen at regular intervals. The Affordable Child Care Benefit (ACCB) data has regular seasonal patterns due to factors like school holidays. For example, ACCB use is lower in the summer months and the last few weeks of December every year. Seasonal adjustment is used to remove these predictable fluctuations, providing a clearer view of the trends in ACCB usage.

Technical Notes:

- (i) The seasonally adjusted number of families and children who are recipients of the Affordable Child Care Benefit have been estimated at the province and school district (SD) levels. By mapping each child care facility's postal code to the geographic area, facilities were assigned to school districts. However, given that SD 93 (Conseil scolaire francophone) represents all Francophone schools located across the province of British Columbia, it is not possible to assign a child care facility to SD 93 using the postal code, as SD 93 is not defined by specific geographic boundary like other school districts. Instead, SD 93 child care facilities are included within the school district where the facility is located.
- (ii) Because seasonal adjustment involves applying a month-specific seasonality index to the actual number of families and children receiving the ACCB, the school district-level data for the 'Seasonally Adjusted Number of Children' and 'Seasonally Adjusted Number of Families' columns (defined below) may not sum to the provincial estimates.
