

## Definitions for Open Data - Headcount of Homeschooled Children

Column	Definition
[Definition of extract]	<p>This extract contains a headcount of school age children that are registered with a public, francophone, distributed learning or independent school as homeschooled.</p> <p>The information is available at the provincial, district and school levels, and is based upon the Ministry of Education's September K-12 student level data collections (Form 1701).</p> <p>The data in this table begins with school year 1991/1992.</p>
[Technical Notes]	<p>Homeschooled children may be registered by the parent or guardian with any school of choice that is operating in British Columbia.</p> <p>A child entitled to enrol in Grades K-9 may either enrol in an educational program with a board of education or register for homeschooling at any school in the province, but not both.</p> <p>A person entitled to enrol in Grades 10 through 12 may register for homeschooling at any school in the province, and also enrol as a student for course(s) in one or more distributed learning schools or programs. However, a person who enrols in Grade 10 through 12 courses offered through a regular school program cannot also register as a homeschooler.</p>

SCHOOL_YEAR	<p>The school year that commences on July 1 and ends the following June 30.</p> <p>For this data set, the earliest school year is '1991/1992'.</p>
DATA_LEVEL	<p>Use this column to select results at the province-, district-, or school-level.</p> <p>Values:</p> <p>'Province Level'</p> <p>'District Level'</p> <p>'School Level'</p>

PUBLIC_OR_INDEPENDENT	<p>Use this column to select only public schools, independent schools, or both school types.</p> <p>Values:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>'BC Independent School'</li> <li>'BC Public School'</li> <li>'Province-Total' (= a rollup of both school types)</li> </ul>
DISTRICT_NUMBER	<p>The number of the school district. This does not include independent school authorities.</p> <p>This value is a 3-digit string (e.g., 005, 023). However, leading zeros may be automatically removed when opening the file in Excel. See the <i>Working with the Headcount of Homeschooled Children extract</i> guide for tips on how to prevent this from happening.</p> <p>For the actual name of the district, please see the column DISTRICT_NAME.</p>
DISTRICT_NAME	<p>The current name of the school district or independent school authority.</p> <p>For the number of the district, please see the column DISTRICT_NUMBER.</p>
SCHOOL_NUMBER	<p>The current eight-digit numerical identifier assigned to the school by the Ministry of Education. This is also known as the Mincode ("Ministry Code").</p> <p>The first three digits are often the district number (geographic district number). However, leading zeros may be automatically removed when opening the file in Excel. See <i>Working with _</i> guide for tips on how to prevent this from happening.</p> <p>For the actual name of the school, please see the column SCHOOL_NAME.</p>
SCHOOL_NAME	<p>The current name of the school.</p> <p>For the number of the school, please see the column SCHOOL_NUMBER.</p>
TOTAL_HOME_SCHOOL_COUNT	<p>The total number of individual homeschoolers that were registered by September 30<sup>th</sup>.</p>
